



## Sparkling wines

*Only sparkling wine made in the Champagne region of France may be called Champagne. South African sparkling wines made in the traditional French method (methode champenoise) are referred to as Methode Cap Classiques or MCC's. Wine that has been impregnated with CO2 bubbles is simply termed sparkling wine whereas MCC's undergo a second fermentation in the bottle to create the sought after bubbles.*

### **Villiera Tradition Brut (Method Cap Classique, dry)**

This bottle fermented sparkling wine is a blend of red and white grapes displaying the full, balanced yeasty complexity synonymous with a wine made in this style. The wine retains its fresh racy zestiness that is a result of crisp acidity and delicate fruit.

### **L'Ormarins Classique Brut (dry)**

This sparkling wine has a delicate peach hue and an appealing aroma of candied apple, citrus pith and light flinty, limestone nuance. Its long aftertaste finishes on a light lemon zest note.

### **L'Ormarins Classique Rosé Brut (dry)**

The L'Ormarins sparkling Rosé has an attractive delicate salmon pink hue in appearance. It has delicious whiffs of charming raspberry and strawberry aromas vie with a peppery spice nuance on the nose.

### **Rooiberg Brut Sparkling Wine (dry)**

This vivacious, light, but dry sparkling wine, has charms of dried herbs and citrus tones and an exuberantly refreshing palate, expertly rounded in a completely dry aftertaste.

## **Sauvignon Blanc**

*Sauvignon Blanc is one of the most popular white wines, which originates from the Bordeaux region in France. It is often referred to as "grassy," and is known for its refreshing crispness, which is due to its high levels of acidity and low amounts of sugar. This wine is referred to be dry and can be paired with pork, vegetable or salad dishes.*

### **Delheim Sauvignon Blanc**

A vibrant and fruity wine with rich gooseberry and grapefruit flavours. It has a fresh asparagus undertone supported by lime aromas.

### **Rustenberg Stellenbosh Sauvignon Blanc**

This is a slightly fuller, richer style of Sauvignon Blanc without relying on the influence of oak. The intrinsic Sauvignon Blanc characteristics of green pepper, asparagus and gooseberry are to be found in this wine, with underlying tones of pineapple and passion fruit.

### **Protea Sauvignon Blanc**

The palate is bold and vivid with more grapefruit and lemon tang but balanced beautifully by ripe, juicy nectarine fruit notes. It has fresh but with a dry flinty nuance as a counterpoint.

This Sauvignon Blanc is fruit driven with loads of freshness and nice sucrose. You can expect granadilla and pear aromas which follow through on the palate.

## **Chardonnay**

*Chardonnay is the Queen of all white wines. It is believed to have originated in the Burgundy wine region of eastern France but is now grown wherever wine is produced. It is usually rather a dry white wine. Due to the wide range of styles, Chardonnay has the potential to be paired with chicken, delicate fish and seafood dishes.*

### **Protea Chardonnay**

This Chardonnay has an attractive tropical bouquet with whiffs of fresh pear, pineapple and rock melon. Hints of zesty lime and nectarine add complexity and balance to the palate as well as providing elegance and structure to the wine.

### **Vergelegen Premium Chardonnay**

This Chardonnay shows an attractive lemony yellow-green colour with a complex nose of citrus, peach, tropical fruit and mineral tones. The palate is long and full with delicate wooding.

### **Rustenberg Stellenbosh Chardonnay**

A traditionally made, barrel fermented Chardonnay with aromas of apricot, coconut and orange peel followed by flavours of marzipan, sponge cake and citrus, rounded off with carefully judged oak and balanced, fresh acidity.

### **The Stellenbosh Reserve Moederkerk Chardonnay**

Aromas of fresh citrus, lime and hints of lemon zest come to the fore, with elegant pineapple notes that support the initial tropical impression. There are undertones of guava and paw-paw which add to the creamy style of the wine.

## **Chenin Blanc**

*Chenin Blanc was born in the Loire Valley in France; with reports tracing the white wine grape back as far as the 9<sup>th</sup> century. Many believe that in 1655 Jan Van Riebeeck took the grape vines from France and first planted the grape at his home vineyard in South Africa. Chenin Blanc is a zesty and crisp wine to be paired with seafood and pasta dishes.*

### **Protea Chenin Blanc**

The Protea Chenin Blanc has a crisp citrus flavour with a tangy lemon vibrancy. It is a lively wine with a lovely light body and gentle persistence.

### **Hoopenburg Chenin Blanc**

Through the cool climate in the Stellenbosh region it gives the wine body and fruit intensity. The nose of the wine is pure fruit flavours with a refreshing finish.

## **Pinot Grigio**

*While most believe Pinot Grigio originated in Italy, it was actually born, like many of the most popular grapes of the world, in France, where it is known as Pinot Gris. Thought to be a mutation of the red grape Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris' skins are not green like other white grapes, but instead have a greyish blue hue, which is what gives them their name.*

### **Protea Pinot Grigio**

The Pinot Grigio is a wine with enticing fresh notes of pear, nectarine and honeydew melon with a gentle lemon undertone. The palate is tangy with crisp, zippy citrus vivacity coming through.

## **Rosé wines**

*A Rosé is a type of wine that incorporates some colour from the grape skins, but not enough to qualify it as a red wine. It may be the oldest known type of wine, as it is straightforward to make. When Rosé wine is the primary product, it is produced with the skin contact method. Black-skinned grapes are crushed and the skins are allowed to remain in contact with the juice for a short period, typically one to three days. The must is then pressed and the skins are discarded, not left in contact throughout fermentation as with red wine making. Rosé can easily be paired with poultry, pork or seafood dishes.*

### **Protea Rosé (dry)**

This dry Rosé has gentle aromas of nectarine and lemon zest, with light fruity hints of plum and red cherry. The Protea Rosé is a lively, vibrant wine.

The De Grendel Rosé is dry however still exceptionally floral and perfumed on the nose with enticingly sweet nuances of lemon and lime carried out of the glass by wafts of Turkish delight and candy floss.

## **Cabernet Sauvignon**

*In the 17<sup>th</sup> century in southwestern France, an accidental breeding occurred between a red Cabernet Franc grape and a white Sauvignon Blanc grape and thus the most popular grape Cabernet Sauvignon was born. The wine is usually dry and has fruity flavours of cassis, and dark fruits such as cherries, along with a hint of vanilla that comes from the wine aging in the oak. The Cabernet Sauvignon has the potential to be paired with beef dishes, especially steaks.*

### **Protea Cabernet Sauvignon**

This Cabernet Sauvignon is juicy and softly rounded. It has appealing aromas of black berry fruits. It has a gentle spice and a cocoa element that adds richness and complexity to the palate.

## **Merlot**

*Merlot is said to come from the Bordeaux region in France. This grape became known for its unique ability to add softness to a wine and is therefore an easy drinking, elegant, red wine. The Merlot can be with burgers or venison dishes.*

### **De Grendel Merlot**

This Merlot is an exceptionally fruit driven wine which is bright ruby garnet in colour. It has enticing aromas of sweet red plum and raspberry.

## **Pinot Noir**

*Pinot Noir, the "black" grape, was born in the Burgundy region of France, where it is still called red Burgundy. It is a very noble vine. Due to the stringent growing requirements for Pinot Noir, it is produced in much smaller quantities than other popular red wines. The Pinot Noir is a rather unique dry red wine.*

### **Peter Falke Pinot Noir**

This unique wine has aromas of red fruit cherry spice and wet leaves on the nose with intense raspberry and strawberry flavours on the palate. It is an elegant wine with soft lingering tannins.

## **Pinotage**

*The Pinotage grape is unique to South Africa and is derived from the noble Pinot Noir and Cinsaut (formerly called Hermitage) varieties. Pinotage is dense in colour and bold in flavour with notes of plum sauce, blackberry and liquorice. It is recommended to be paired with steaks, goulash or lamb dishes.*

### **Delheim Pinotage**

A Pinotage, rich crimson in colour which has juicy, red fruit favours supported by undertones of perfume and cloves are detected on the nose. It has a soft and elegant finish with subtle oak, which results in the perfect balance.

### **Hoopenburg Pinotage**

This medium bodied, fresh and fruity Pinotage has aromas of strawberries and raspberries, with subtle hints of coffee and chocolate on the palate.

## **Shiraz**

*Shiraz came to prominence in the 18<sup>th</sup> century in the Rhone Valley in France. It is one of the darkest red wines, which tends to be heavy and dry, known to be full-bodied. It is recommended to pair it especially with hearty dishes or cheese.*

### **Protea Shiraz**

The Protea Shiraz has gentle plum and black berry compote aromas, with a light pepper nuance. The first impression is one of succulence: a juicy palate of ripe plum and black berries. Hints of tobacco leaf and liquorice can be found in the rich and lingering spicy finish.
